A ministry worker shared:

"Yindi\* has started reading Bible League's Plain English Version books of the Bible, and they've aided her quiet time. She's also used them as an evangelistic tool, giving them to her family members, confident that they'll understand them.

"We've also been using the PEV for funerals, and countless people have been comforted by the Psalms. It's an invaluable aid to our ministry in remote Australia. and we are thankful."

Emily, a teacher at Nungalinya College in Darwin says, "I find the Plain English Version very helpful for those who are not confident readers, or speakers, of English. It makes the Scriptures more accessible."

And a Christian worker at a school for Aboriginal children reports:



"... The PEV Gospel of Mark really does speak the students' language. I've also downloaded audio versions of the New Testament Plain English Version books, which are read by mature-age Aboriginal women. When I play those recordings, the kids are rapt."

#### You're helping Endrit pray for his enemies – and find hope!

Endrit\* was born into a Muslim family like most around him in Albania. But after receiving a Bible, he "came to know Jesus"!

He now prays for his enemies who've been attacking his Christian community:

"Radicals don't like to see a church. The pressure is big. Sometimes they scream when we're inside to don't let us quietly pray and worship God. Some set fire to the door. Others threw stones to break the glass. They damaged my car.

"I was upset, but decided to pray for them and ask God to intervene. Then things became much more quiet."

Studying God's Word helped changed Endrit's attitude as he did what Jesus said:

You have heard...'Love your neighbour and hate your enemy.' But I tell you, love your enemies. Pray for those who treat you badly. Matthew 5:43-48 ERV

Adesh, a married man with five children, grew up in a strict Hindu home but became a Christian when his daughter was seriously ill. He shared:

"We took her to the doctor, who was unable to diagnose her. We then decided to take her to a prayer meeting. We heard many were getting healed there.

"As the pastor prayed, we saw our daughter get healed, and we trusted in God."

Now, Adesh is reaching others in his region with the message of God's love. He says:

"The Church Planter Training was very useful. We've planted more house churches and



delegated responsibilities. I have witnessed many abandon their idols to live for God."
