Bishop Onismo, National Director of Bible League International in Zimbabwe, sat down to share more of how you're helping to transform lives across the country...

In 2024 alone, we planted seven new churches in different villages. People are welcoming our programs with open arms as we continue to receive more scripture materials in the local languages and in the English language.

The spiritually incarnated dark world is very active here. We've got witch doctors... we've got people who are initiated to raise the spirits of the dead and use them for their own means.

So the truth of the Gospel is really needed in this nation.

Families which would have divorced are going through the Bible-based programs. Couples are learning to reconcile and come together. Others are newlyweds, or youths who could have been involved in drug and substance abuse.

NDUTA SAYS, **"I HAVE NOW COMPLETELY** CHANGED" THROUGH PROJECT PHILIP!

Your support to resource the under-resourced Church is changing many lives in Kenya, including 11-year-old Nduta's*.

After suffering abuse at the hands of her mother, Nduta was adopted by a Muslim family and taken into their home. She lived a lonely life – until she joined a *Project Philip* program at school. Nduta shares...

"I joined the Project Philip program; I had to ask for permission from my guardian, since I had become a Muslim, and she agreed.

"I liked the Bible stories in the booklet and the memory verses. The book made it clear that God loves me."

The discovery of God's love for Nduta transformed her heart and mind. Her efforts in class and her behaviour at home changed significantly. She says...

"I have now completely changed, and my teachers and guardians are happy with me. I received Jesus, and I believe I can follow Christ totally."
