From a "hot-tempered" convicted murderer to a passionate evangelist within his prison walls, Patrick's life has been totally transformed by the Bible... thanks to the generosity of friends like you!

Shortly after Patrick attended his father's funeral back in his hometown in Kenya, he went drinking with an old friend. But it was far from a happy reunion.

The two men got into an argument and "fought furiously" according to Patrick. In the morning, his friend's body was discovered.

Patrick was arrested and charged with murder. He says:

"I was an alcoholic... I was a hot-tempered man who couldn't control my anger. I only loved those who loved me and there was no joy or peace in my heart."

Sent to prison, Patrick was soon living in despair.

"Life in prison is difficult, with many hardships... one faces threats from fellow inmates. We are very many confined in a small space. I can compare it to hell."

But friends like you enabled him to join a Project Philip Bible study group - and, living in hell, Patrick found the hope of heaven.

He now encourages the prisoners around him to put their faith in God and experience His forgiveness and peace, saying...

"Many inmates claim they're innocent and harbour bitterness and unforgiveness... I have learnt that forgiveness is key to freedom while in prison. I learnt how God, through Jesus Christ, forgave me and how I should learn to forgive others."

As Patrick serves his sentence, he knows that God loves him and has released him from guilt and shame. He is longing for the day when he is released so he can take up ministry in the outside world. But for now, he has a mission to share the freedom and forgiveness of Jesus with his fellow inmates. He says:

"Through Christ's love and grace, I received peace and my anger within was released... I may be in prison, but I am free in this regard. I am no longer a slave of sin, but I'm free from sin. Hallelujah!"


"Matthew 4-6 helped me understand who God is and what kind of life He expects us to live," Akein says.

## **CHANGING LIVES: PASTOR TSHABALALA REACHES THE NEXT GENERATION**
